PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AND SIGN

Your pet is scheduled for anesthesia/surgery. We recommend a blood profile to ensure that your pet is in a low risk category prior to anesthesia. The latest technology has enabled us to run safe and accurate blood chemistries minutes before anesthetic induction. These tests are similar to those your own physician would run were you to undergo anesthesia. In addition, the results of these tests will serve as reference values for future use should your pet become ill.

There will be a \$35.00 exam fee if your pet has not been seen here within 3 months.

PET MICROCHIP IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM - "HOME AGAIN" COST - \$60.00

This is the most complete nationwide system for recovering lost or stolen pets. It utilizes a tiny microchip about the size of a grain of rice, which is implanted under the skin between the animal's shoulder blades. When a lost pet arrives at a participating animal shelter or veterinary hospital the code is scanned and the owner is identified immediately. The procedure takes just seconds and is relatively painless. It may be used in dogs and cats, 6 mos. or older, of all breeds. While your pet is under anesthesia we can painlessly microchip your pet for permanent identification.
